#### XIV. CHALK FOR MARKING PASSENGERS' BAGGAGE.

The Board have approved, for use by the Waterguard Staff in marking passengers' baggage, a new type of chalk of a softer consistency, and with a protective covering of paper. The chalk, which is packed in boxes containing 144 pieces each, should be requisitioned under the following description, viz.:—"Chalks, 3, assorted colours, covered paper," the form of requisition (Form C & E 632 or Form C & E 632 M) being amended accordingly pending reprint.

Supplies are to be requisitioned forthwith, and on receipt thereof the existing stock of old chalk is to be returned to H.M. Stationery Office, Salvage Depot, Loman Street, Gravel Lane, London, S.E. 1.
