DIRECTIONS TO MASTERS, OFFICERS AND CREWS OF VESSELS CONCERNING THE DECLARATION OF GOODS OBTAINED ABROAD OR DURING A VOYAGE

1. **COMPLETING THE FORM OF DECLARATION**—This form must be completed and handed to the Customs officer who first visits the vessel. The declaration must be signed by the master, and each officer and member of the crew; signatures of Asiatics may be attested by the serang. If more than one form is required, the forms should be fastened together and numbered consecutively. The master's certificate need be given only on the last form.

2. **WHAT MUST BE DECLARED**—All articles, however small the quantity, obtained abroad or during a voyage whether for yourself or for some other person and whether intended for this country or not.

3. **WHAT MUST BE PRODUCED TO THE CUSTOMS OFFICER**—Everything obtained abroad or during a voyage.

4. **WHAT IS CHARGEABLE**—Most articles imported are chargeable with Customs duty and purchase tax.

5. **DUTY-FREE ALLOWANCES**—Members of a crew who remain on a vessel during her stay in port may be allowed, under certain conditions, to keep for their own use on board small quantities of any tobacco, spirits and other goods declared on this form. These goods must not be landed without the permission of a Customs officer.

Members of a crew finally leaving a vessel with their effects may be allowed to take ashore for their personal use free of duty small quantities of tobacco (including cigars and cigarettes), spirits or perfume declared on this form.

6. **IMPORT LICENCES**—Import licences are required for some articles but as a concession members of a crew may be allowed to land without a licence certain articles declared on this form and produced to a Customs officer provided that any Customs duty and purchase tax have been paid and the articles are not for sale.

7. **PROHIBITED GOODS**—Among the goods which must not be imported are :—

**DANGEROUS DRUGS (FOR EXAMPLE OPIUM (RAW OR PREPARED); MORPHINE; HEROIN;
COCAINE; CANNABIS (INDIAN HEMP), INCLUDING HASHISH; STIMULANT DRUGS OF
THE AMPHETAMINE TYPE.)**

FLICK KNIVES

HORROR COMICS

OBSCENE BOOKS, PHOTOGRAPHS AND ARTICLES

UNCOOKED MEAT AND POULTRY.

8. **RESTRICTED GOODS**—Among the goods subject to restrictions are :—

DOGS AND CATS

FIREARMS, AMMUNITION AND EXPLOSIVES

PARROTS, PARAKEETS, BUDGERIGARS AND ALL BIRDS OF THE PARROT SPECIES

PLANTS, TREES AND VEGETABLES

PLUMAGE.

9. **SURPLUS STORES AND LIVESTOCK**—These must be listed on the ship's report and produced to the Customs officer first visiting the vessel.

10. **OTHER GOODS, INCLUDING ARTICLES FOR SALE**—Packages of goods, e.g. for sale or trading or for presents, which are not on the ship's report are to be listed on Form C.143 and produced to the Customs officer first visiting the vessel.

WARNINGS :—

1. Any person who makes or signs, or causes to be made or signed, any declaration relating to the Customs which is untrue in any material particular is liable to a fine or imprisonment or both, and the goods to which the declaration relates may be liable to forfeiture.
2. Any article not declared on this form is liable to forfeiture and the person concerned liable to prosecution.
