I. COAL CARGOES AND BUNKERS.

A copy of the Directions given by the Board of Trade dated the 8th ultimo, suspending the restrictions hitherto existing in regard to the supply of coal bunkers and amending those relating to the export of coal, is forwarded herewith.

General Order 79/1920 is to be amended by the cancellation of paragraphs 7 to 10 inclusive.

On page 7 of the Board of Trade Directions dated the 8th November 1920, the name of Mr. E. Slough is to be replaced by that of Lieut.-Commander W. J. Thompson, and the name and address of Mr. H. Bamber by those of Mr. Frederick Max Witzel of Park Place, Cardiff.

Circular C 7 dated the 8th January 1921 is hereby superseded and cancelled.

II. WATERGUARD SERVICE. PREFIX "MR."

The Service is informed that in future subordinate members of the Waterguard are to be addressed with the prefix "Mr."

This instruction gives effect to a decision of the Departmental Whitley Council on the subject.
