6.—CARRYING DEVICE FOR ELECTRIC LAMPS SUPPLIED TO WATERGUARD OFFICIALS.

For the greater security of electric lamps, the Board have approved the issue of a carrying device to each member of the Water-guard Service who is in possession of an official electric lamp.

The device, which should be generally used, consists of a metal hook attached by a swivelling pin to a leather tab, and should be hooked on to the ring attachment of the lamp and tabbed on to the trouser button over the pocket. A trouser button of the "Bulldog" type with a metal fitting affords greater strength than the button of ordinary type.

Requisitions for supplies required in their districts should be made by Chief Preventive Officers through their respective Superintendents to the Superintendent of Stores, Customs and Excise, 5, Jewry Street, London, E.C.3.
