Certificate of Carving and Marking Notes

The certification of Ships Carving and Marking Notes is not proper to the grade of Coast Preventive Man.

It is necessary to the certifying of these markings that the certifying official should be aware of the contents of Section 7 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894, and of the method of marking required to satisfy that Section, as covered by paragraph 192 of the Instructions to Registrars of British Ships.

Local officials should be made aware of this position and persons applying for inspection and certification of markings at places not listed in paragraph 192 should be referred to the local office of the Senior Ship Surveyor of the Ministry of Transport. At places covered by the list the certificate should be given by an Assistant Preventive Officer or officer of higher rank.
