



1. NATURE OF DUTIES. Land Preventive Men will be required to assist the Officers of the Customs and Excise Service in the performance of their duties at Stations and Posts along the Northern Irish side of the boundary between Northern Ireland and the Irish Free State. On occasion they may be required to act by themselves, under directions given to them by the Customs and Excise Officers.
2. APPLICATION. Application should be made to the Collector of Customs and Excise, Custom House, Belfast. If the applicant has a preference for employment in any particular district or districts, he should state it in his application.
3. LIMITS OF AGE. The maximum age limit is 45, and candidates must be in receipt of a life pension from the Army, Navy, or Police Force.
4. REQUIREMENTS. Candidates are required to furnish information as to previous employment (supported by certificates of good character) proof of age, and satisfactory evidence of good health, good eyesight, hearing and capacity to perform active duties and to show their ability to write intelligently, and legibly and to make simple arithmetical calculations.
5. PAY. The pay will be 58/- (fifty-eight shillings) a week inclusive. This rate will be subject to revision should there be any appreciable alteration in the cost of living. Employment as Land Preventive Man will not carry with it any claim to pension in respect of such employment.
6. HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT. The hours of employment are uncertain; they extend over Sundays and Public Holidays and will include attendance as required by night as well as by day. No overtime or extra pay will be allowed. Employment will be based on an attendance of 48 hours in

a 7 day week on the average throughout the year.

7. LEAVE OF ABSENCE. Subject to the requirements of the Public Service, leave with full pay is allowed for 16 days a year. For purposes of pay during sick leave Land Preventive Men will come under the ordinary operation of the National Health Insurance Acts, no departmental sick pay being allowed.
8. UNIFORM. Land Preventive Men are required always to appear on duty neatly dressed and wearing the prescribed uniform, which will be supplied to them by the Department. Boots will not be supplied.
9. RESIDENCE. No official residence will be provided, and each Land Preventive Man must find his own house accommodation
10. TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT. Employment may be terminated at any time on a month's notice, but in the case of misconduct a man will be liable to instant dismissal.
