Dear Sir,

I am directed by the Commissioners of Customs and Excise to inform you that you should report for duty as an Assistant Preventive Officer, on trial for a period of one year, in a supernumary post at Aberdeen.

You should report to this office at 9 a.m. on Monday, 18th July 1966. I have to point out to you that in order to preserve continuity of service, there should be no unauthorised break between your last day of service in your present grade and the 18th July.

Although your assignment is on a permanent basis as far as removal, etc. expenses are concerned, you will only be occupying a supernumary post at Aberdeen and accordingly, unless you secure a vacancy within the approved complement of this or any other port you will be liable to compulsory transfer. Your attention is drawn to Establishment Instructions Volume 7, Part V.

Within a short period of taking up duty you will be called to a Training Centre in Southend-on-Sea, Essex to be given a course of instruction lasting about two months.

For the purpose of the Graduated Pension Scheme of the National Insurance Act, 1959, you will continue to be contracted out.
