

Customs Notice

UNITED KINGDOM RESIDENTS

You must declare all articles obtained abroad, or on the journey, or obtained in the United Kingdom free of duty or purchase tax, except the duty-free allowances.

PERSONS RESIDENT OUTSIDE THE U.K.

You should tell the Customs Officer how long you are going to stay or if you are about to take up residence in the United Kingdom.

All passengers must declare all goods for commercial use; professional effects, and any prohibited goods, including drugs, firearms, plants, meat and live animals.

DUTY FREE ALLOWANCES

There are no allowances for persons who go abroad and return within 24 hours.

The duty free allowances for other passengers are:-
