

Customs Notice

UNITED KINGDOM RESIDENTS

You must declare all articles obtained abroad, or on the journey, or obtained in the United Kingdom free of duty or purchase tax, **except** the duty-free allowances.

PERSONS RESIDENT OUTSIDE THE U.K.

You should tell the Customs Officer how long you are going to stay or if you are about to take up residence in the United Kingdom.

All passengers must declare all goods for commercial use, professional effects, and any prohibited goods, including counterfeit coins, dangerous drugs, firearms and ammunition, plants and bulbs, radio transmitters, meat and live animals.

DUTY FREE ALLOWANCES

There are no allowances for persons who go abroad and return within 24 hours.

The duty free allowances for other passengers are :-

SPIRITS	one bottle (0.75 litre)	
WINE	one bottle (0.75 litre)	Only
TOBACCO GOODS	250 grammes or 500 grammes <i>if you live outside Europe</i>	for persons of 17 or over
PERFUME and TOILET WATER	0.30 litre (10 fluid ounces) <i>of which not more than half is perfume</i>	
CIGARETTE LIGHTER	one	
OTHER ARTICLES	£10 worth
