



NOTICE BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

BOARDING STATIONS FOR SHIPS ARRIVING AT OR DEPARTING FROM PORTS OR PLACES IN GREAT BRITAIN OR NORTHERN IRELAND
