**2.—Scholarships at the Royal Military College of Science, Shrivenham.
(EST 311/5/39.)**

The Ministry of Defence has now agreed that the Shrivenham Scholarships may be open to women. The full details of the scholarships are given in Omnibus Weekly Order 36/1971 Part 2(c) which should now be read in that sense.

Accommodation cannot be provided for women students within the College and it will be necessary for them to take private accommodation outside the grounds.

In view of this amendment to the conditions of eligibility belated applications by women applicants will be accepted provided that they are received in the Training and Staff Development Unit not later than 11th October, 1971.

**3.—Civil Service Bursaries for studies in Computing Science, Science,
Economics and Statistics for 1972-73. (EST 311/5/34.)**

Bursaries will again be available under the auspices of the Civil Service Department in the 1972-73 academic year for the benefit of candidates wishing to take a university degree or an equivalent qualification. Those selected will take courses leading to qualifications acceptable for entry to the Scientific Officer Class, for posts as Advanced Systems Designers on work on Government computer projects and for entry to the Economist or Statistician Classes.

These schemes are directed towards people who may ultimately be considered either for class-to-class transfer or for promotion. The Selection Board will take as much account of the personal qualities and potential of the candidates as of their ability to obtain the necessary academic standard in the degree examination.

Candidates are expected to make their own arrangements for admission to universities, polytechnics, or colleges of technology. Intending university students should apply to the Universities Central Council on Admissions for places by 15th December, 1971. Entry to the bursary schemes is open to civil servants, whether serving on established, unestablished, or temporary terms, who have completed eighteen months qualifying service.

The minimum standards are:—

Computing Science

The candidate should:—

- (a) be in the age range of 20 to 35. (Applications will be considered exceptionally from candidates between 35 and 40 who have had good, recent experience in the A.D.P. field and in respect of whom their departments are prepared to make special recommendations);

- (b) already possess a suitable first degree and needs a one or two-year course to acquire an acceptable post-graduate qualification or, though not a graduate, is considered likely to obtain a good degree after a full-time course of which computing science is a principal subject;

Science

The candidate should:—

- (a) be under 31 years of age in the year in which the course is completed;
- (b) already possess a suitable first degree and needs a one or two year course to acquire an acceptable post-graduate qualification, or, though not a graduate, has the necessary university entry requirements for a degree in Science, Engineering or Mathematics;

Economics

The candidate should:—

- (a) preferably be in the age range 20 to 35. (Applications will be considered exceptionally from candidates between 35 and 40 who have had good recent experience of work in the economic field and in respect of whom their departments are prepared to make a special recommendation);
- (b) already possess a suitable first degree which would enable him to gain admission to a university for a one or two-year post-graduate course; or
- (c) already possess a first degree but would be better suited to taking a second first degree in economics; or
- (d) although not a graduate have experience of work with a significant economic content, have proved his aptitude for it, and be considered likely to obtain a good degree in a full-time course having economics as its principal subject.

Statistics

The candidate should:—

- (a) already possess a suitable first degree and need a one or two year course to acquire an acceptable post-graduate qualification; or
- (b) have studied for, but not obtained a degree and be thought capable of obtaining one by less than three years full-time study; or
- (c) though is not a graduate be considered likely to obtain a good degree in a full-time course of which statistics is a principal subject; or
- (d) be a non-graduate of proven ability and with considerable statistical experience who is nevertheless considered by his department to need full-time formal training in statistics before he is suitable for class to class transfer to statistician. He should

be capable of completing this training by no more than two years of full-time study, e.g. by a course leading to Parts 3(a) and 3(b) of the examination of the Associateship of the Institute of Statisticians.

A single application form has been designed to cover all the schemes and this, together with a note giving full details of the schemes, can be obtained from Training and Development Officers.

Completed application forms are to be passed, via Training and Development Officers, to Collectors or Heads of Offices. Collectors and Heads of Offices are to send forward to Training Research Sector, Training and Development Unit, only the applications of those officers whom they regard, on the evidence available, as showing outstanding promise or, for the Economics bursary, have experience of work with a significant economic content and have proved their aptitude for it.
