**Coast Preventive Men and Land Preventive Men: Revised rates of pay and conditions of employment.**

The following particulars of an agreement of the Departmental Whitley Council are communicated to the Service for information.

*Coast Preventive Men.*

*Pay* (Consolidated rates).

105s. 0d. x 2s. 6d.—117s. 6d. per week.

*Hours of attendance.* It is agreed in principle that the hours of attendance shall be an average of 48 a week of 6 days and that normally one day off duty, not necessarily a Sunday or Public Holiday, shall be allowed each week. The day "off" should vary from week to week and should not follow a regular sequence. It is recognised that Revenue interests must be the first consideration in arranging times of attendance.

It is further agreed that, pending the filling of vacancies and the completion of arrangements to cover weekly absences, this part of the agreement will remain in abeyance for the time being.

*Assimilation.* Existing staff to enter new scale at the minimum except in the case of men on their maximum, or deemed to have reached their maximum by accrued increment, before the operative date, who will receive a special increase of 6s. 0d. a week over the old maximum.

In all cases the operative date will become the new incremental date.

*Operative date.* 1st January, 1947.

*Land Preventive Men.*

*Pay* (Consolidated rates).

100s. 0d. x 2s. 6d.—110s. 0d. per week.

*Hours of attendance.* 48 hours a week during Monday to Saturday inclusive.

*Assimilation.* Existing staff to enter new scale at the minimum or if it is more favourable, at their existing pay plus accrued increment (not exceeding the old maximum), including 8s. 0d. war time allowance, plus consolidation addition, plus a special increase of 5s. 0d. Land Preventive Men at their maximum, or deemed to have reached their maximum by accrued increment, before the operative date, to receive instead a special increase of 6s. 0d. over the old maximum.

In all cases the operative date will become the new incremental date.

*Operative date.* 1st January, 1947.

*Overtime.**Weekdays.*

First 6 hours	...	...	...	...	Time rate and a quarter.
Next 6 hours	...	...	...	...	Time rate and a half.
Thereafter	...	...	...	...	Double time rate.
<i>Sundays and Public Holidays</i>	...	...	...	...	Time rate and a half.

*Night attendance.* Attendance between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. to reckon towards the weekly aggregate and for attendance on Sundays and Public Holidays at the rate of seven hours for six, i.e. one sixth extra.

*Minimum credits.* As for Watchers (Establishment Instructions, Vol. 2, paragraphs 128, 128A, B, C, and D).

The revised scale of pay for Land Preventive Men includes the temporary war-time allowance which will accordingly cease to be payable from the operative date of the new scale.

The necessary instructions in regard to the revised pay of the staff concerned and payment of arrears will be issued by the Accountant and Comptroller General as soon as practicable.

Arrears of overtime in consequence of the new conditions for Land Preventive Men should be assessed locally as from 19th October, 1947, inclusive, as soon as the revised rates of pay have been notified.

The necessary amendments to the standing instructions will follow in due course.
