You are required to attend the WATERGUARD TRAINING CENTRE for PRIMARY COURSE No. 42..... which will commence on TUESDAY the
15 APR 1958..... and extend over a period of TWO MONTHS,
ending on -7 JUN 1958.....

ASSEMBLY. Trainees will attend at 9 a.m. on the morning of 15 APR 1958..... and will take over their lockers in the COMMON ROOM, Ground Floor, Custom House.

At 9.45 they will assemble in the Lecture Room (adjacent to the Common Room).

UNIFORM. Trainees should come provided with uniform, inc. greatcoat or raincoat.

CODES ETC. Codes and Books of instruction will NOT be required.

ACCOMMODATION. Trainees are expected to find their own accommodation. If however, you are unable to do so, you should communicate with the Welfare Officer, Waterguard Training Centre, who has a limited number of addresses.

SUBSISTENCE. The normal subsistence rates will be paid for the first 28 nights away from home, and Lodging allowance will be paid for the balance of the period at the W.T.C. except in the case of Officers who intend to reside in parental or marital home who are not so entitled.

WEEKDAY LUNCHES. Lunches are available to Trainees at the Customs and Excise Refreshment Club. These are provided at low rates.

The main Refreshment Rooms are at King's Beam House, nearby, but there is also a Cafeteria, on the 1st floor, Custom House where light refreshments may be obtained.

TRANSPORT. The nearest Underground Stations for Custom House are:-

MONUMENT, TOWER HILL, BANK.

LONDON BRIDGE and CANNON STREET (SOUTHERN RAILWAY) stations are a few minutes walk from Custom House, Lower Thames Street.

SPORTS. Arrangements can be made for trainees to participate in field games during week ends. Those who are interested should pack the necessary gear.
