EXTRA REMUNERATION (exceeding 25l.):—

Five Housekeepers, &c., receive about 160l. yearly for extra attendance.

A considerable number of Preventive Officers and Preventive Men receive extra remuneration in excess of 25l. per annum each for Overtime Pay, Night Pay, and Sunday Pay (see under B. 4).

In addition one Waterguard Superintendent, Second Class, and five of the Chief Preventive Officers (shown under B. 1, page 7) are employed in the Office of the Inspector-General of Waterguard.

An allowance of 50l. per annum for the services of a Surgeon at Gravesend is included under B. 3.
